**US Air Carrier Announces First Ever Flights To Rum Cay Bahamas To Serve Celebrity Property Owners**

A US based Air Carrier today announced the first ever flight service to Rum Cay (pronounced Rum Key), Bahamas from Ft. Lauderdale, Florida up to four times per week. Ft. Lauderdale, FL (PRWEB) January 12, 2010 – US based air carrier, Locair, announced today that it will provide flights to Rum Cay, Bahamas from Ft. Lauderdale, Florida to service the island's celebrity property owners. The company also announced that it will add additional flights on an as needed basis to keep pace with the steadily increasing demand for property on the island.

Flights to Rum Cay, pronounced "Rum Key" and located approximately 350 miles from South Florida, will be regularly scheduled as part of Locair's flight service to Long Island. Flights currently depart on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays with times to be determined on a seasonal basis.

These flights will also provide the citizens of Rum Cay and the Southern Family Islands direct access to the United States, significantly saving them time and money. This flight service is expected to immediately benefit the residents of Rum Cay and Long Island. We are very excited to partner with The Paradise Is Mine Company, Turnberry Realty and Sunshine Realty.
